We are seeking access to all Australian HealthPathways through to 31 July 2026. The study is funded by the Australian Medical Research Future Fund (MRF2045099, CIA Barlow).

Aim of this study

The primary objective of this study is to bring GPs, clinicians and people with lived experience of concussion together to co-design conversation tools and strengthen existing HealthPathways to improve the concussion care pathway. To inform this work, we will map and review concussion and mild traumatic brain injury (mTBI)-related content within HealthPathways across Australia to better understand the current national landscape.

- Mild Traumatic Brain Injury;
- Head injuries in Adults and Children; and
- Any relevant content embedded across multiple Pathways.
